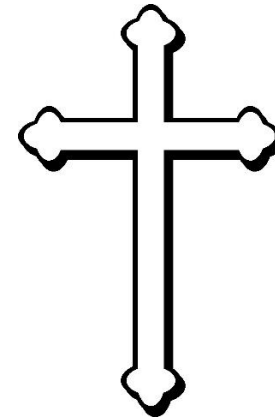

### **Foundation Repair Project:**

In May, an Engineer from Rock Dove Engineering did an assessment of the Church foundation. A work package outlining proposed foundation repairs was created and sent to several qualified companies, by Rock Dove Engineering. The closing date to submit bids for the project was May 17, 2024.

On Sunday May 19<sup>th</sup>, Parish Council met to review the bids. Two bids were received and presented to Parish Council with company names removed. They were labelled Company 1 and Company 2. The successful bid submitted by Company 2, was chosen based on the total cost being \$15,554 lower than Company 1 and the start date of June 2024 compared to April 2025. The successful bidder by a unanimous vote was Novacam. Novacam company president, Chris Ingram, was informed of the decision made by Parish Council.

The cost of this project will be \$68,200 plus \$10,230 hst = \$78,430 total. Novacam can order materials and schedule the work as soon as they receive the first payment of 30%. The next payment of 35% will be required at the halfway point in the project and the remaining 35% at completion. The work is expected to take approximately 2 months.

We will receive a \$4,000 grant from our City Councillor, Patty Cuttell. Sandra Whitehead has applied for a grant from the Anglican Foundation and will submit a grant application to the Diocese. At this time, we don't know if we will receive money from these grants, how much we might get, or when we would receive it. For this work to start as soon as possible we will have to withdraw funds from our investments. Parish Council has approved the withdrawal of \$27,453.84 from our investments to begin the project. If we don't receive grants we will have to withdraw up to the full amount of the project from our investments. We currently have \$298,743 invested through the Diocese.

We will keep you informed on the funding and progress of this project.
